

PROPOSED BYLAWS CHANGES
NOVEMBER 13, 2011 CONGREGATIONAL MEETING

TVUUC Bylaws - Current	Proposed Revisions
<p>Article III. MEMBERSHIP</p> <p>1. Any person who is in sympathy with the programs and purposes of this Society may become a member by signing a membership book or card, but the status of voting member, having the right to vote at business meetings, shall be reserved for members who have also prior to the meeting attained the age of sixteen years and who have been active members for at least six weeks prior to the meeting. Membership is terminated upon members' written request or upon Board action following appropriate inquiry.</p> <p>2. Further references in these Bylaws to membership in the Society shall mean voting membership, unless otherwise specified.</p>	<p>Article II. MEMBERSHIP</p> <p>Section 1: Eligibility A person may become a member of TVUUC who is at least sixteen years of age, who subscribes to the mission and values of TVUUC, who considers TVUUC their primary place of worship, who intends to actively participate in the activities and programs of the church community, and who makes a pledge to financially support the church. One becomes a member upon signing the membership book.</p> <p>The minister may waive the requirement for a pledge based on financial need and pastoral considerations.</p> <p>Section 2: Register of Members There shall be a register of all members. Membership shall be reviewed annually. Members who have requested resignation shall be removed from the register immediately. Members who do not respond to membership status inquiries shall be removed after a period of one year.</p> <p>Section 3: Resignation of Membership Any member may resign at any given time by giving notice to the church office.</p> <p>Section 4: Reinstatement of Membership Anyone who has been dropped from the Register of Members may be reinstated by requesting the Membership Coordinator for reinstatement, subject to meeting the requirements for membership.</p>

<p>Article VI. OFFICERS (excerpts)</p> <p>3. The Secretary-Clerk shall take the minutes of the meetings of the Society and the Board. The draft proposal of the Secretary-Clerk's minutes of meetings shall be prepared promptly. Board minutes shall be available in the church office in sufficient time to accompany written notice of a Board meeting sent to each member of the Board. Society meeting minutes and Board meeting minutes shall be approved by the Board and posted in the church in a manner conducive to congregational inspection, and shall thereafter be available in the church office for congregational review. The Secretary-Clerk shall prepare official correspondence and make revisions in official records of meetings as directed by the Board. Copies of all minutes and official correspondence shall be sent promptly to the church office for filing. The Secretary-Clerk's records for the past year shall be turned over to the incoming Secretary-Clerk.</p> <p>5. The Board shall designate an Assistant Treasurer who will conduct routine banking responsibilities as authorized by the Board, including making deposits, approving bills for payment, and signing checks drawn against the church operating account.</p>	<p>Article V. Other members may be added to this group subject to the approval of the Board of Directors.</p>	<p>VI. - ~~d. Chair-elect of the Nominating Committee to serve one year as Chair-elect and one year as Chair~~

~~5. In addition, nominee(s) shall be presented for the position of Canvass Committee chairperson elect, who shall be elected for a two-year term and shall automatically succeed to the position of Canvass Committee chair at the next Annual Meeting.~~

6. Furthermore, nominee(s) for **Trustee**-at-Large will be presented for three-year terms.

7. The names of all nominees shall be made available to members of the **Society** at least eight (8) days prior to any election. If the Committee has not been able to find a nominee for any position, this should be communicated to the President at least eight (8) days prior to any election. Nominations from the floor shall be in order.
